

Venue Setup

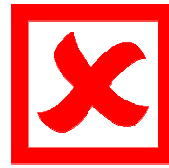
Picking the right venue will make your murder mystery much better!



Good Venues

Completely private space where guests can not see or hear other people:

- ◆ You must have your own space where you are the **only** people using that room
- ◆ Rooms with minimal furniture and plenty of space to move around are perfect
- ◆ Your house, function centres, the office, halls etc. are all great



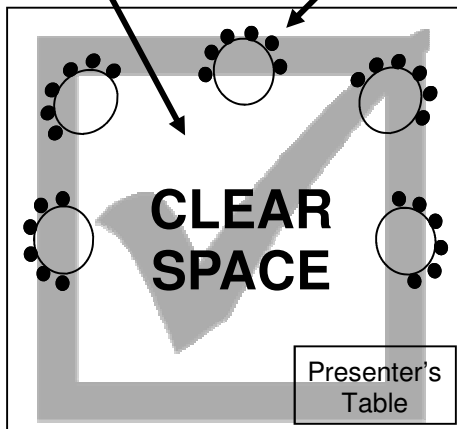
Bad Venues

Avoid these venues:

- ◆ One section of a restaurant
- ◆ Rooms shared with other patrons
- ◆ Spaces separated with a curtain or partition
- ◆ Spaces with noise from nearby patrons
- ◆ Rooms with music playing next door or "piped" music which your group has no control of
- ◆ Venues with unmovable furniture
- ◆ Restaurants or rooms full of furniture with little open space
- ◆ Mysteries on trains or boats can work, but will be much harder for your host to manage

Have lots of empty space to move around.

Have 5 groups of chairs or chairs and tables.



Your host will want:

- A **Presenter's Table** which is completely cleared
- Access to a **CD player**.
